## **AUCTION RULES**

Every effort has been made to describe items completely and correctly.

All items are sold "as is" without warranty or representation of any kind as to the correctness of description, condition, or quality. All sales are final and must be paid for on the day of the sale. No items may be removed from the premises until payment is made.

Each successful bidder must check in and receive a paddle number and is responsible for paying the bid amount (Live Auction). All bidders by virtue of accepting their assigned paddle number agree they have read these terms. Cash, checks, Visa, Master Card are all accepted. All sales are final. You may elect to make one payment to cover multiple winning items.

In the event of a dispute, the auctioneer will act as the final authority. Any sales or excise tax will be paid by the purchaser. All items and services must be used within the stated time limit and are subject to the terms and conditions stipulated by the donors. The maximum time limit for any live auction is one year from the day of the Auction, in this case September 9, 2023. All sales are final.

#### Raffle Auction - How to Bid

We're trying something new this year - Bidding by raffle ticket!

Buy 25 tickets for \$100 (that's \$4.00 each)

or

Buy 50 tickets\* for \$175 (that's \$3.50 each)

\*The discount for 50 tickets is only available as a bundle of 50 tickets purchased at one time during the evening.

Each ticket is a chance to "win" a silent auction item.
Place as many tickets as you would like per item.
Winners will be drawn at random after the live auction.

#### **Live Auction**

Live Auction items will be displayed or described by the Auctioneer. Each item is assigned a number. Simply raise your bidder paddle to bid on an item. You may bid on as many items as you wish and you may bid on an item more than once.

## **Checkout From Your Phone**

You can securely checkout from your phone with a credit card. Once you have a checkout available, a red "Pay!" button will appear at the top of your bidding screen. Tap on this button to proceed to checkout. If you have not already put a credit card on file, you will need to do so at this time in order to check out from your phone. \*For checkout, wait until all auction items (silent, live, appeal) have closed.




